CALL TO ORDER

MAYOR

Mayor Michael F. Curley said that under the law we are required to present the budget that he prepared, with the help of the Treasurer, Mr. Gregg Smith, and Mr. Michael Genito, as well as our Department Heads. He thanked the Village Board for working with him throughout the years to make it a great place to live and continue to keep up that good work. He then asked the Village Clerk to hand out the 2025-2026 Tentative Budget to the Board of Trustees.

Mayor Curley said, "I'll just let the Board know and let the public know that it reflects a Zero percent tax increase for the fourth year in a row. There will be no tax increase to any residents and in this budget. We still, at the same time, we fulfill all the needs of our community and our residents, and we will continue to do so." He also stated that there will be a zero percent tax increase on the water and sewer as well. Mayor Curley stated that it is a solid budget. He said that there will be a public hearing on April 7, 2025, the public can state their concerns. The budget will be on the website and the public can come and get hard copies as well.

He thanked everyone for working on the budget and stated that we all love the community.
